GLOW Gently Loved Outfits to Wear

Clothing empowers people and GLOW is the flagship program of New Circles. This past year, with your generous help, we assisted 14,422 equity-deserving individuals. Many of our clients are new to Canada and have had to flee their homes and their country because of war, fear of persecution or are refugees seeking asylum. Often, they arrive with only the clothes on their backs and are rarely prepared for the harsh Canadian winters.

GLOW, set up just like a retail store, is a free service where we offer a respectful shopping experience. Free clothing ensures that our clients have their additional dollars to spend on food and housing. This is critical support and through your donations we are pleased to report the following results this past year:



We are proud to have assisted 14,422 equity-deserving individuals in our community.

GLOW also serves as a retail training and customer services platform for our clients who graduate through our Retail and Customer Services Skills Programs. At New Circles, we know that clothing is just the beginning. Our focus remains on ensuring that we set up our clients for success, help them to build employable skills and help them transition into the workplace.

Building Skills and Changing Lives

Business Office Skills, a free, 12-week full-time training program for women, combines virtual instructor-led training and hands-on or remote experience in administrative and/or customer services positions. Participants complete a 70-hour paid work placement with partner agencies in the Greater Toronto area. Upon completion, graduates receive transferable college credits and certification from Centennial College. Offered twice a year, our graduates improve their business communication and presentation skills, learn how to write resumes, and practice job interview skills. Clothing is provided from our GLOW store to ensure that our graduates look and feel their best as they move forward with their job placements.

Our Retail and Customer Service Skills is also offered free of charge and is a full-time, 12week program that includes a combination of virtual learning and hands-on experience in our GLOW store. Every successful graduate receives the Retail Sales Associate Certificate from the Retail Council of Canada.

Graduates develop problem-solving and time management skills, build up their professional confidence and gain valuable work experience through our GLOW store.

"I don't know where I would be without the help of New Circles. Because of their skills training program I found a job and my life has completely changed. I can provide for my family. I can hold my head up high."



Moving to a New Country is a Culture Shock.

At New Circles we understand there is an adjustment for our clients as they get used to new foods, languages, customs, people, and surroundings. With your support, we are here to help. We assist in connecting our clients with housing, childcare, accessing social assistance such as Ontario Works, and navigating the immigration process.

The Settlement Support Program offers support to immigrants to Canada with personalized information, referrals, workshops, and other supports, in order to meet needs and assist with challenges beyond basic clothing.

Message From Our Interim Executive Director and Chair of the Board

Fiscal year 2021-2022 was a year of transition for New Circles. Our employment team had already transitioned to online learning. And, we began reaching out to shelters to deliver clothing and to food banks and other community services to promote our services. Eventually, we began to re-admit clients at a safe pace and with the requirements of proof of vaccination and masking.

We were emerging from the pandemic. Regrouping. Relaunching. Aiming to bring back and grow our client base. And, just as we were re-emerging, we found ourselves in the midst of staff turnover in key positions.

We chose to frame the last quarter of our fiscal as a wonderful opportunity to focus on organizational readiness. On team readiness.
